With this idea, SAMPARC in association with Belladonna Organization, Italy started this unique Project for Women & Girls to Develop Confidence by helping them to become employable or capable of earning to contribute in the Gross Income of their respective family.

The journey started in August, 2015 for Skill Development of the Girls & Women of Village Khajurol and its surrounding villages near Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India.

The Courses are the same till date and Course-wise number of Trainees is given below. –

Presently **Total 68 Trainees** are getting benefit of our effort for their Skill Development. They will be promoted to the next level and there will be now admission in Basic Level of each course.

"Advanced+" category has been cancelled from all the Courses.

Both Theory & Practical Classes are going on regularly.

Till date, **501 Girls and Women** have been Trained from this centre and are now able to contribute to their family earning.

The Project implementation Team is very much Strict about Discipline, Course Structure – everyone should pursue the Basic level to be promoted to further level – so that proper Skill Development of the Beneficiaries can be possible.

Project Manager Mr. Digvijay Singh is looking after the day to day activities of the Project and is working hard to enhance the activities to reach to more beneficiaries to create real social impact in the target area.

Vandana is from village Samadpur, 4 Km away from our Training Centre. She came to know about SAMPARC Vocational Training Centre from her Grand Father who was present there during Inauguration of the Centre in August, 2015. She came to the Centre for information and after discussion & counselling, she decided to pursue Tailoring Course.

She was very much interested in Tailoring and attended Classes regularly. She used to come by Cycle to the Centre with the dream that she will be able to earn for her family.

Now Vandana is earning Rs. 3000/- (Approx.) per month and is happily contributing to her family.

We can see that, she is more confident that before and she is happy and full of dignity for herself being able to contribute to her family income.
